



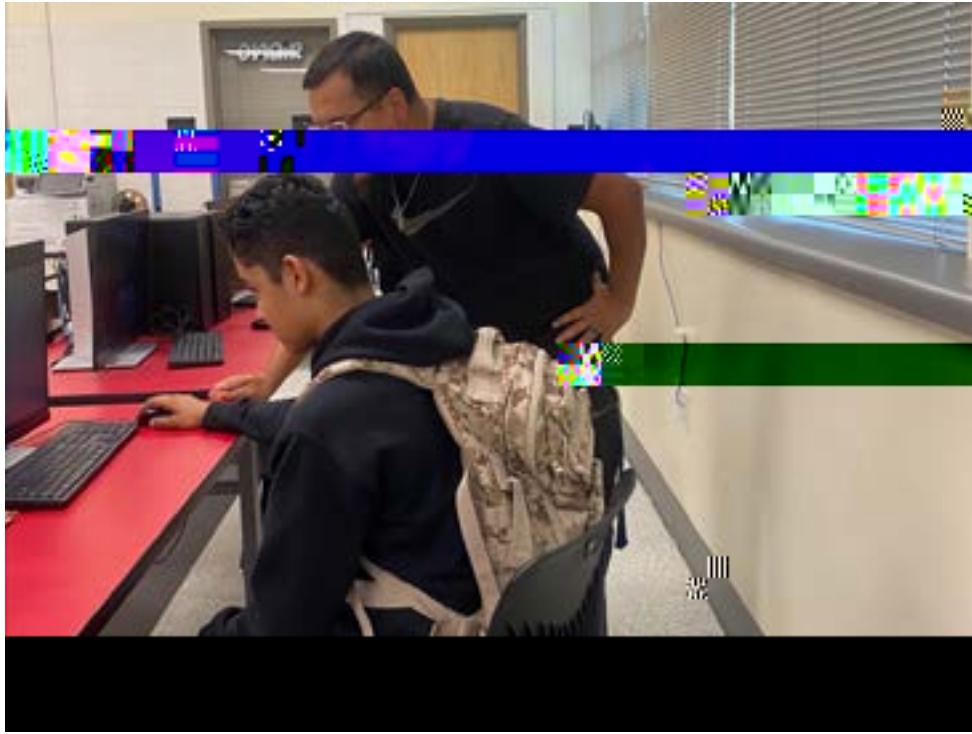
Thank You, Principals!
