Graduate Council (Cieminski) GC has not met yet this year. 799 still in Codification.
Liberal Arts Council (Matchett) LAC has not met yet. All courses approved, except for one.
Professional Education Council (Mahovsky) No report.
Undergraduate Council (Welsh) Note that a grade of C- with a professor of one class, could be a grade of C with a different professor, depending on their grading scheme. Departments with higher prerequisite requirements can adjust their grading schemes to compensate.

Another loophole would be for a student to re-take a pre-requisite class at a community college and transfer a better grade to UNC to get into next level class. Registrar's Office will have to manually monitor student S/U registrations and applications as well as historic credits (labor intensive). Registrar's Office would like to offer an impact statement prior to launch due to work intensity of S/U grading option. Codification made suggestions to the area of catalog language on computing GPA, which only needs the addition of an S-. Decided to leave original language for now, and take up improving language at a later date.
