Salary Equity (Clinefelter (for Kyle)) –

- SEC's proposal to increase the d\$6250. Marshall has worked the numbers and it works with the budget. SEC reviews promotion amounts every 3 years, yet perhaps it should be part of university policy. A discussion about flat rate versus percentage increase followed.
- SEC declined a proposal from Haddad concerning amending the SEC Bylaws in Article VI (I)(d)(3). SEC does not want to qualify the exception to the rule as it is contradictory to their idea of equity. Additionally, there is already a process where administrators can appeal.
