xIEP enrollment status –catalog language (APC)

o Vaughan presented language that clarifiestforle status for students in the Intensive English ProgramEP).

The revised talog language aligns with appropriate federal regulations IEP students with F1 or J1 visas are considered if the if enrolled in 18 classroom hours.

The Registrar's Office and CIE approve of the language as presented.

xPrior degree credit applicability – catalog language (APC)

To earn a <sup>2d</sup> BA. students must:

xhave at least 30 additional UNC credits after their first BA, and xmeet all major requirements.

MOTION: APC –It is moved to approve the revisions to the Second Baccalaureate section of the Undergraduate Catalog.

VOTE: Approved by voice vote.

#### xSenate bylaws(Codification)

- o Codification took up the issue of revising Faculty Senate bylaws after the inclusive pronoun resolution was passed.
- o Upon review, the committee found many areas where language could be cleaned up.

Removal of the Elections Committee (which no longer exists)

Revision to made sentences consistent across various sections of the bylaws

Removal of the duplication of committee duties (where appropriate)
Revision of the Salary Equity section to be consistent with current Salary
Equity bylaws

- o Each Senate committee reviewed and made recommendations for their respective sections of the Faculty Senate bylaws.
- o Amendments to the Faculty Senate bylaws require attimes vote and two readings, so we will only be reviewing today, not voting to approve the revisions.

#### **DISCUSSION:**

- o Remove the extra prepositional phrase typo in Article VI, J.
- o Consider revising the format of the committee membership sections for consistency

Note: Membership allotments for Salary Equity and Codification are different fromthose for Faculty Welfare and APC, which may have a variable number of Senators numbering at least five.

- o Levin will take the recommendations back to Codification.
- o Haddad asked about the driftion of internal parity in Article VI, I. 3. d. and whether it impactsuniversity hiring.

There are no impacts on university hiring. The definition of internal parity is used by Salary Equity to examine parity among various university groups.
