1. Ensure the cable is tightly connected from the port on the wall to the input on your TV or, if applicable, external QAM tuner
2. If applicable, connect the external QAM tuner to the TV
3. Run a channel scan as described above (Expect 125 channels between 2-85)
4. Verify that your TV has the proper QAM tuner, see the list below or search the specifications section of your TV manual. If you no longer have your TV manual, locate the make and model of the TV and lookup the specs online (See our list below)
