

**PROGRAM AWARDED FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE
AVAILABLE TO SPEECH-LANGUAGE PATHOLOGY
GRADUATE STUDENTS**

Full-time, regularly-enrolled students seeking the M.A. degree in Speech-Language Pathology can apply for financial aid. Financial aid is made available on a semester basis and renewal is contingent upon quality of work performance (if applicable) and academic eligibility (3.0 or higher GPA for most awards). The amount of work required (if any) and the stipend associated with each award are indicated below.

Departmentally Awarded Financial Assistance

1. Full-Time Graduate Assistantship

Full time tuition (13-16 credits) and up to 10 credits of fees. This award requires 270 hours of work per semester and is awarded based on merit. The position requires the recipient to participate in the teaching and/or research activities of faculty or staff members. Specific duties may include library research; data collection, entry, management and processing; preparation of instructional materials; grading; coordinating training and use of instrumentation; maintaining laboratory equipment, etc. Both non-resident and resident awards are available.
