- a. Exams will be graded by the selected instructors within 2 weeks after the exam and the Graduate Schdowill be informed of the results by the deadline established by the Graduate School.
- b. Each exam is evaluated as either pass or fail, as determined by the exam wainter the standard of 70% as passingle exam scores are compiled by the NTAcademic Advisor into a final result (i.e. pass, conditional pass, or fail).
  - i. Pass A student is considered to have passed the itten comprehensive exams if 100% of the examcommittee (3examiner) agrees a student has passed
  - ii. Conditional PassA student is considered to have a conditional passtheir written comprehensive exams it,100% but >33% of theexamcommittee (2 of the 3 members) agree the student passes
    - 1. If this happens, the MSIT Academic Advisor will convene the committee of 3 earniners to make a collective decision on the overall conditionsor further actions.
    - 2. A student may be recommended to retake the exam a gaia subsequent semester. Spolicy is students can only take the entire comp exam once a semester for a maximum of two attempts.
    - A studentmaybe provided with the specific conditions and timeline to complete the conditions to transition to pasthe timeline will never be more than 12 weeks
    - 4. A student may be required to write on a particular area or question(s) of a written exam, as determined by the committee.
    - 5. If conditions are not met by the date provided by the committee members the student is considered to have "Failed" their comprehensive exam
  - iii. <u>Fail</u>: A student is considered to have fail their written comprehensive xams if 33% or less of theommittee (traditionally 1 of the members) agrees a student has passed.
    - 1. The committee must determine if the student is allowe'theatake" of their comprehensive exam
      - a. If this is permitted, the retake must be completed by the end of the following semester. A retake may not scheduled during the same semester that the original examination was completed.
        - i. If a student does not pass after a retakte, eir program will be terminated.
      - b. If a retake is NOT permitted, the student's programill be terminated
- c. Notification of individual exam results and overall written comprehensive results
  - i. Following evaluation, exam writers will notify the MIST Academic Advisor their decision for their exam (i.e. passfail) and may also directly notify the student, at their discretion.
  - ii. TheMS-NT Academic Advisorill compile the individual exam results to determine the final decision. The MST Academic Advisor and the Chair of the SBS Graduate Committee will sign \*\*Meport of Written Comprehensive Exams: Master's Degree Non-Thesis" to file with the Graduat&\*Chooland SBS

1. The results of the written comprehensive examinations must be reported to the Graduate School no later than deadlisseablished by the Graduate School if taken during the student's final semester to ensuremeeting gaduation requirements.
