Improvements were made to the webaite ing information about petitiode adlines, proposal guidelines, and the purpose of each competition. Faculty continue to express concerns over the timing of the Provost Award for Travel (PAT) deadlines. PAT guidelines stipulate that each competition willravelsibility within certain dates (with flexibility at the discretion of the FRPB and with preference given to international travel beyond the posted travel dates). PAT review processes include consideration of acceptance of juried presentations or performes. Consequently, some faculty regularly travel to conferences whose dates fall within the range for one PAT competition, but the faculty often do not have confirmation of abstract acceptance or details of travel by the PAT deadline. FRPB leadership recently discussed the issuens in gitne by el costs using PAT funds when reservations were made prior to the PAT review.
