Immunizat on records of en are needed for entry into childcare, schools, camps, and new jobs, as well as travel abroad. If you are seeing a new healthcare provider, you will need this informat on to ensure you receive proper medical care. Providers usually count only those vaccine doses that are documented in a writ en record or a state or local online immunizat on informat on system (known as an "IIS," or registry). No nat onal registry maintains this informat on. So, if immunizat on records are lost or not available, you or your child may need to repeat vaccine doses. Here are some ideas that might help you piece together old immunizat on records.

PLACES YOU MAY WANT TO CHECK:

- All previous healthcare providers Don't forget vaccinat on visits you made to local public health departments or neighborhood clinics. When physicians ret re or a medical pract ce changes hands, old pat ent records may be sent to a medical record storage company. You may be able to obtain records directly from the company for a fee.
